

## **Seymour Whyte wins \$43 million road project**

Company to upgrade Brisbane Water Drive and Manns Road in West Gosford

Infrastructure engineering and construction group Seymour Whyte Limited (SWL) gets \$43 million contract to upgrade, widen and realign roads in West Gosford on the New South Wales Central Coast.

SWL Chief Executive Officer David McAdam says the contract shows the company can win contracts outside Queensland.

“The West Gosford project is another example of our ability to secure projects which are highly complex in nature and require a strong working relationship with the client,” McAdam adds.

Brisbane Water Drive and Manns Road are vital links between Gosford, Woy Woy, and Narara, providing access to railway stations, local businesses and retail centres, as well as the Central Coast Highway and the F3 Freeway.

Key objectives of the project, which involves construction of roadworks, bridgeworks and associated activities, is to improve safety, reduce congestion and lower the number of crashes while increasing capacity and accessibility for all commuter groups.

Work is expected to commence later this month and will be completed by December 2015.
