

## **Toll Group announces changes to its board**

Leading transport and logistics supplier, Toll, appoints new director and advises the departure of another

Toll Group, Asia Pacific's largest provider of transport and logistics, yesterday announced that Mr Kenneth John Ryan AM would join the board as a non-executive director.

Ryan, whose career spans more than 30 years, is employed at Qantas where he has held a number of senior positions including Group General Manager of Marketing, South East Asia Regional General Manager for Qantas and British Airways, and Chief Executive of Jetstar Asia.

Toll also announced that Paul Little AM will no re-join Toll's Board of Directors due to other commitments, but will continue in his role as a member of Toll's Singapore Government Business Board.
